Wheel Pottery Tools



TOOL KIT GUIDE

SPONGE is great to use slightly damp to rewet clay, especially in areas where clay is drying too quickly or starting to crack.

METAL RIB

is used of finishing touches, fine-tune smoothing.

NEEDLE TOOL

is ideal for drawing, writing, and scratching. Be careful of the sharp point! *not included in all kits

WOODEN KNIFE

has two sides. The pointed side is great for cutting and larger line work drawing. The curves side can be used to compress seams.

WIRE TOOL is

used for cutting hunks of clay off the block.



FETTLING KNIFE

is used for cutting slabs or small parts of clay. *not included in all kits

RIBBON TOOL is used to carve, make holes, hollow out thick areas of clay, or create pattern/texture.

WOODEN RIB

is used to smooth and compress clay. It also has a 90° edge, which can be used to help keep walls straight.
