

General information on the west side residential survey project

The survey report, Iowa Site Inventory forms, and photographs on this CD were prepared as part of a research/survey/nomination project in 2014-15 funded by a Historic Resource Development Program (HRDP) grant (part of Resource Enhancement and Development (REAP) program) from the State Historical Society of Iowa for the intensive level architectural and historical survey of the residential neighborhood on the west side of Washington (W. Main, W. Washington, W. Jefferson streets to Sunset Park). The information on the Iowa Site Inventory forms relates to evaluation from the 2014-15 survey project. Boundaries and contributing/non-contributing status of the buildings may change slightly as a National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) nomination project moves forward in the future through its research, review, and approval process. The final NRHP nomination would reflect any modifications to the final boundary and building statuses after the preparation of these Iowa Site Inventory forms.
