- Expertise in an activity or piece of equipment represented in the MakeIT Place (sewing, 3D printing, laser engraving, vinyl cutter (Cricut), button maker, scanning/digitizing photos, video or sound, podcasting, musical recording, graphic design software, potter).
- Patience, flexibility and curiosity.
- Basic computer skills (Mac OS preferred).
- Attentive and able to follow written or oral directions.
- Interact and communicate successfully with others.
- Ability to deal with messes and clean them up cheerfully!
- Time commitment: Varies based on area of interest/activity.
